
The Call

The I3 Instrument supports the cooperation between EU Member states regions and partners in policy areas supported by smart specialisation strategies (S3), with a particular focus on the participation in interregional innovation investments pipelines. It supports interregional innovation investments using S3 as the coordination principle.

Strand 1 of the I3 Instrument targets consortia of innovation actors from regions which are ready to make investments in interregional innovation projects. These investments can consist of a portfolio of coordinated and interlinked investments in the participating regions. This portfolio approach foresees the identification, within a specific thematic/technological area of cooperation, of a number of investment-ready sub-projects that address one or several bottlenecks identified in the project proposal. **Typically, these investments will serve to strengthen, connect, or expand existing value chains, while creating local innovation and smart economic transformation opportunities.**



CyberFense is led by the Castilla y León Innovation Valley, with the Junta de Castilla y León regional administration support





















What we look for
